History

Built and partially fitted by Alken Engineering, Helicida II was fitted out by the current owners who have lived aboard and cruised her extensively. The hull was blacked with bitumen and the engine serviced in 2016.

This is a 'Gas Free' boat and currently has no fitted cabin heating or gas cooker – although a disused hearth and flue outlet is present.

Composting Toilet

Hull & Exterior.

Material / build: All steel. Thicknesses: 10mm base – 6mm hull – 5mm cabin



Exterior: Black bitumen painted hull to rubbing band. Blue from rubbing band through side decks. Blue painted cabin sides.

Windows: Gold Anodised portholes and glazed opening side hatches.

Forward well: Rope fender. Steel cants. 'T' stud. Integral storage locker. Self draining steel well deck. Glazed timber cratch board and canvas cover. Two central half glazed, timber lined steel doors to accommodation.

Roof: Cream painted roof. 4 x brass mushroom vents, disused solid fuel stove flue outlet, life ring, pole and plank in holder. 6w solar panel. Sliding hatch over access aft and fitted pram cover.

Aft deck: Rope fender, 2 mooring dollies, steel cants, diesel filler. Tiller steering. Self draining deck. Deck hatch to access below. Two central timber lined steel doors to accommodation.

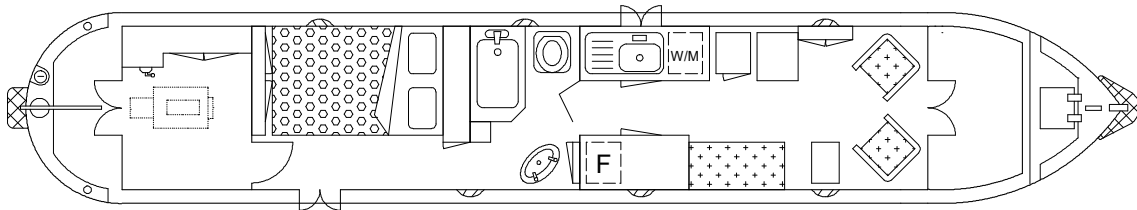

Cabin Arrangement: Bedroom / Bathroom / Galley / Saloon



Berth arrangement: 2 berth - fixed double in own cabin

Cabin 1: Steps from engine room lead into the bedroom. The 6' 5" x 4' double bed is on the portside, with storage space below. Cupboards and an LCD TV are mounted overhead on the aft bulkhead. Storage with hanging space is arranged on the forward bulkhead with shelving above. Passageway continues forward into ...





Cabin 2: Bathroom. Across the aft bulkhead on the portside is a white plastic hipbath, with a white tiled surround. Sun – Mar composting toilet. To starboard is a mirrored cabinet above a white ceramic pedestal basin. Passageway continues amidships through bi-fold door into...

Cabin 3: Galley. stainless steel sink and drainer unit on portside set into timber worktop with Candy washing machine and cupboards below. 240v Microwave mounted on aft bulkhead to starboard side, above additional worktop with Shoreline 12v fridge below. Please note that there is no gas cooker. Open plan into...



Cabin 4: Saloon. 2x red leather armchairs, and some freestanding furniture. A disused tiled hearth is fitted centrally on the portside, with a cushioned occasional bench seat to starboard, this can be used as a double sleeping area. Two timber lined half glazed steel doors lead out to the forward deck.
